

This Deed made this the sixth (6th) day of January in the year one thousand eight
hundred & twenty three between Allen Brantley grantor of the one part and K. R. Griffin
shown at trustee (both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia) witnesseth that
the said Allen Brantley doth grant with general warranty unto the said K. R. Griffin trustee
aforesaid the following real property to wit all certain tract or parcels of land lying in the
aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded by the lands of R. J. H. Kelley, G. C. Board,
and on the land of James Bradshaw alias, and containing by estimation one hundred fifty acres
more or less, to wit the tract or parcel of land known as the "Holloman's Land" or tract, and
bought by the said Allen Brantley from Holloman family & married A. his wife of the
State of North Carolina & by date stated above December 1872 conveyed by said Holloman
to the said Allen Brantley, said land being conveyed by said Allen Brantley unto said K. R.
Griffin in trust to satisfy the following debt to wit, and note made by said Allen Brantley,
and dated the 1st day of January 1873, and payable to W. W. Moffatt & Sonder & Pearson
under the form & style of W. W. Moffatt & Co. said note being due December 20th 1873.

This Deed made the 1st day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and seventy three (1873) between C. Vaughan and Antoinette his wife, and John S. Gay Jr.
of all the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part, and Newland Council
of the County and State of one of the second part, witnesseth that the said C. Vaughan
doth give and grant to John S. Gay Jr. of the first part, so and in consideration of the sum of Ten thousand
two hundred fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Newland Council of the second part
to the said C. Vaughan wife & C. S. Gay of the first part, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, the said C. Vaughan Vaughan wife and John S. Gay Jr. have bargained and
concluded and by the said parties freely taken and sold and confirmed unto the said Newland
and Antoinette his wife and assigns forever all of their right title and interest in and to one hundred &
a forepart of land lying and being situated in the County of Southampton State of Virginia,
and in the Village of Bramble which runs the N.E. & N.W. Roads commencing at the
east corner of the lot formerly owned by the said C. Vaughan whence along the said Edwards line
210 feet to first corner thereof along the line of said corner to the edge road that formerly
ran from Bramble about to Mill's water Bridge 225 1/2 feet, thence down the edge of
line of old road to the Rail road bed 209 feet thence along the said road line 153 feet
to top first station to last and to hold the aforesaid lot or parcels of land and premises
together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way appertaining, subject
unto the uses of Newland Council and his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only
