Noted by a court of the Circuit Court of Cumberland County, made out
with red ink, eight hundred and twenty - . in the court house, witness'd by J. T. Thompson & wife
for myself and the Plaintiff, Robert and Elizabeth L. Kelly and executed on the 1st day of April, 1871,
(who are appointed Commissioners for that purpose), present to sell the real estate which the Plaintiff
Robert Kelly does own and has, on the land and buildings now in the same. I, Robert Kelly, do make this
Robert Kelly Commissioner of sale, present to sell above described lands and buildings, and do make the day
of October 1871, before the Court house of said County (Living Court day) all at auction or at
such real estate office, when the following forms will be presented by Mr. J. E. Lawrence at its price
four hundred fifty dollars and - cents, that is to say a tract of land in said County con-
taining two hundred and eighty acres, more or less, and bounded as follows:
lot subject to the first claim of Mrs. Harriet Hallinan as here left off and of the purchase
money for the said lot, \$750.00, a sum paid in cash the sum of \$160.00 one hundred and sixty
and twelve thousand five hundred and twenty dollars and no cents per acre. And whereas the
plaintiff deposed on said Court, made on the day of May 1871, in said cause, it was
agreed and ordered that the said Robert Kelly Commissioner of sale, collect of the said
Mr. Lawrence the sum of five hundred one hundred dollars and all interest thereon, and
repose the said lot to him, I, Robert Kelly, do close with special warranty in the usual form, for the real
estate aforesaid, and that he has his price. This deed therefore, makes this 1st day
December one thousand, eight hundred and twenty two, between the said Robert Kelly as
Commissioner of sale, of the real estate, and the said Mr. J. E. Lawrence of the other part, witness'd
that the said Robert Kelly as Commissioner of sale, in consideration of the sum of money
in execution of the last aforesaid decree, with special warranty, unto the said
Lawrence, and to his heirs and assigns of forever, the land of record, and its rights whatsoever.
