of said debt with this for sufficient bonds delinquency and demand and carrying interest at the rate of five per cent per annum due by  
the said Peter Egan to the said J. P. Brown and J. C. D. Brown, and it is agreed by the parties of the said Peter Egan that he  
should release years to liquidate the said debt, provided the interest paid promptly at the expiration of three  
months from this date and annually thereafter, George H. Brown and J. C. D. Brown, and it is further agreed
