9<sup>th</sup> Delivery of Cypress logs to be made when sufficient numbers shall arrive to float them to the river mouth the party of the first part shall have the privilege of applying Credit No. C. to the writing of drawables by such books of the first part after the payment of the interest upon said delivery of said Robert Hart of late on fifteen days of November 1872.

10<sup>th</sup> It is further agreed by the contracting parties that no advantage shall be taken of any infirmity in the writing by either party concerned.

11<sup>th</sup> A bill of lading wherefore he party to said persons have bound to due hours and date the 27<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven.
