Ex' 2 And said made the 23<sup>d</sup> day of January 1879 before Robert Ridley and Lucy A. his wife, of the  
one party, and Joseph H. Barnes of the other party, testifying, that in consideration of the real Estate  
hereinafter mentioned he deponent and complainant in exchange for said Robert Ridley and Lucy A. his wife, set the  
said Joseph H. Barnes to the said parcel of land, namely H. Barnes did grant convey and exchange unto the said  
Robert Ridley, and his heirs forever with general warranty a certain parcel of land situated in Loudoun  
County containing by actual survey, 20 acres, and 40 rods, the boundary East and course of said parcel  
is a line being of old trees, beginning at a large pine tree, thence a line N 60° E to a large white oak tree  
thence a line N 55° E to an oak tree (dead tree) thence a line N 35° E to a large oak thence a line N 35°  
E thence a line N 75° E to a small red oak, thence a cloddy line N 75° W to the starting point, thence  
being a part of the tract of land on which the said H. Barnes now lies, the said Robert Ridley to have and to  
hold the said parcel of land in exchange for parcels hereinafter particularly mentioned and described to be noted  
as follows, to wit, the said Robert Ridley & Lucy A. his wife, to be sold for H. Barnes. And the said land also  
hereinafter set forth in consideration of the said parcel of land, being so situated and bounded unto the said Robert  
Ridley as aforesaid, to the said Robert Ridley and Lucy A. his wife, still great convey and exchange in  
trust to the said Joseph H. Barnes and his heirs forever with general warranty the parcels of land  
lying in Loudoun County, and containing 7 acres, 2 rods and 10 poles, as follows, the boundary line of said property  
being at first, beginning at an oak tree on the main road, going down to a drift, thence a line  
N 10° E to a large red oak, thence a line S 85° W to another large red oak, thence a line N 10° E to the  
middle of a hawks, thence up the bank to the main road, thence down the road to the starting point  
and so continuing by actual survey, 22 rods, 10 poles, and 32 feet, the boundary line of said property  
being at first, beginning at a large pine tree, thence a line N 45° W to the Blue Creek, thence up the  
blue Creek to the Longstone Spring, thence up the Longstone Spring, thence to the Longstone  
Spring, thence a line N 55° E to a large pine tree, thence a line N 75° E to the starting point
