This deed made this 9th day of May 1873 one thousand eight hundred and twenty three between W. C. Briggs and Ann Eliza Briggs, his wife, of the one part, and Geo. B. Briggs, Charlotte Briggs, Clara Ann and Richard Emma Briggs, to a certain piece or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereof of the other part witnesses: That in consideration of the friendly feelings that we entertain for the cause of Christianity we do grant with the said Jonathan H. Smith all of our right title and interest we have in the land hereby conveyed and do hereby certify and vero vero veritate and certified as follows, we the Clerk by the next reading of the said Deed and were sent to the Tucker Swamp road, on the North by the next reading from the North to the North and then south by the land of the said W. C. Briggs. This deed described land is bound to the trustees aforesaid as long as the Church is kept up as a house of worship and if the house should be neglected as a house of worship for two years then the aforesaid is to revert to the original owner.
