This deed made the 9th day of May 1873 one thousand eight hundred and twenty three between W. C. Dugg and Annelope Briggs his wife of the one part and Geo. W. Rogers, Wm. C. Rogers, Cicero Ross and Richard Moore trustees to a certain piece or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereof of the other part (to-wit: that no consideration of the friendly claims that we entertain for the cause of Christianity we do grant unto the said Trustees all of our right title and interest we have in the land hereby conveyed unto and to the children and issue now or to be and should at all times be the said Cicero Rogers and the British and ever shall to the Trustees aforesaid, on the North by the said Cicero Rogers and the said Annelope Briggs and each by the lands of the said W. C. Duggs. This deed described land is bound to the Trustees aforesaid as long as the Church is kept up as a house of worship for the use of the said Trustees as a house of worship for two years then the aforesaid is to revert to the original owner.
