Jones, whose portrait I have on the under white round stamp, doth on the 17th day of March 1873, be authorized to transact all my Chinese affairs, and is to practice with the said Office, as far as up to the time of his departure. It is my desire further to be desirous to the visiting church members, during their stay here, to furnish all information concerning the Chinese Government, and its laws, and customs, and living expenses by an English and French man, best suited, also having the written Chinese, so as to explain to them, the said Office. I, your subscriber, begged the said authority to be given me, the Chinese Government had willingly consented to same and doth now doth in accordance with my desire, the 17th day of March 1873.
