This Deed made this 4th day of June 1873. between C. Edmund Gillie of the one part and George R. Branch of the other party, all of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia. Whereas, That for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars \$800.00 in hand paid to the said C. Edmund Gillie by the said George R. Branch - the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, to grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George R. Branch his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land lying on the Attawomish Creek in the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia, and containing one hundred and forty three acres (178) to the river above all else, and bounded by the lands of Daniel Gillie, and Asaph Gillie late Jacob Town and others. During the same last named year of eighteen seven, together with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any way pertaining to have and to hold the same forever. The right and title to the said land I warrant quitclaim. In witness whereof I have hereunto signed my hand and affixed my seal the 9th day of June A.D. 1873

Branch, of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia of the first part and Wm. P. Gillie, Gentleman of the same County and State, of the second part. Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar, lawful money of the United States to him duly paid, doth give and grant unto the said Wm. P. Gillie the sum and parts of the second part his name being Wm. P. Gillie one hundred and forty three acres of land, he now resides and also the said George R. Branch party of the first part doth further grant his interest therein in all cases growing on same to Wm. E. J. Branch, resides and known as the Brinkley Bridge tract, and also all other interests in lands purchased of Charles Gillie by way of Gloucester to secure a debt due to James H. Corlett of the same County and State aforesaid by three notes of first note due January eight 1872 for one hundred and fifty four \$154 dollars, second note due January first 1873 for thirty one \$31 dollars, and third note due March first 1873 for one hundred and forty six \$146 dollars.
