Mr. Industrial made and entered into the 27<sup>th</sup> day of Decem. 1873, before the Hon. C. H. Morris of the County of Gloucester in the State of Virginia of the first part, & C. H. Morris of Gloucester County, Virginia, of the second part, witnesseth, that whereas he had, C. H. Morris, of said County, of late head of a small farm, in the said parish, Waterford, that about the said C. H. Morris, of said head of a small farm, in the said S. S. Harris, Colvin Fortnight (Glover) and sufficient to make him to carry on his farming operations as a new branchville in the County of Gloucester of course, for and during the year 1873, to the amount of Seven or \$7.00 (\$76.73) dollars, and for which the said S. S. Harris shall make to him as all effects of his acts as bonds for that amount bearing no date and the said amount yearly will, and due and payable at the first day of November 1873. And in order to avoid the payment of the late indebtedness growing out of the amount of money, and in consideration of all debts to the party of the first part, as have been paid by the party of the second part, the said S. S. Harris party of the first part, has granted, bargained, and sold, and do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Mr. Morris party of the second part, and his heirs, the following property, to wit: All that certain tract or parcel of land situated in

and bounded as follows:

etc. all or any of every kind and description whatsoever which may be created upon that certain tract or parcel of land and in the possession of the said party of the first part, and to be exhibited by him or under his direction during the year 1873, situated in Gloucester County, Virginia. Also, the following other agricultural implements, to wit: One long shovel and one old flat-tail broom, that of the said party of the first part, shall remain in the payment of said indebtedness on maturity thereof, together with all interest accrued thereon, it shall then be the duty of the said party of the second party to sell the property herein except, or so much thereof as may be necessary, at public auction to the highest bidder for sale on the premises of record, after due advertisement of such sale at the courthouse door and place of sale in the County of Gloucester of record, after the proceeds of such sale to the payment of the costs of executing the trust, including a fee of five per cent to the trustee on the amount of sales, and to the payment of the indebtedness herein before described, together with all interest that may have accrued thereon and the balance, if any, to be paid over to the party of the first part by the said, executors, administrators or trustees. But of all said indebtedness shall be paid at the maturity of the note aforesaid, then the rest to be paid out of the estate. And as a further assurance, the party of the first part hereby certifies and affirms the said party of the second part that the said lands and houses aforesaid are situated in the named place and stead of the said party of the first part, to appear in any Court of competent jurisdiction in the State of Virginia, after the said note becomes due, to answer several of process, and to confess judgment in favor of the said C.
