Moved on the 25th day of September 1828 W. H. Peale, husband of William Elizabeth, and Joseph H.
Elizabeth, Executrix of Old H. Elizabeth dec'd, as of late Clerk Special Commissioner by due duly records, whereof

hereinafter set forth, and as indicated by a diagram annexed: But therefore the said made the day and year of October
1828 between the said C. Howell and the first party and said Bain & Howell a share of the second party, Whereas
that in note that a just partition of said lands may be had between the parties of the first party and the
parties of the second party, and that any of them, their heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, may from hence
forth, lawfully, have and enjoy, in tenancy, without any disturbance of each other, his and their portion and any
part of the said land, then the said Peale and Bain & Howell by their joint mutual consent and agreement, have
made partition and division, and by these presents do, for themselves, and their heirs and assigns make partition
and division of the said land, in manner and form as follows: That it is agreed, that the said W. H. Peale shall
have for his portion and partition of said land, the following land several parcels to wit (First) - the south
part of said land with the house thereon on the south side of the Knobbs and Petersburg Rail road and
East side of the County road and in the angle formed by said road, to the same were subject (Second), with
or joined to said land on the East side of the County road, leading from New Castle to Berlin, beginning at a tree
post on side of said road and running along said road at a distance of forty feet from the road and twenty five feet
to opposite end, the last of front the said of the said road, being three hundred and twenty five feet and

that the said division and partition of said land shall be divided by former between the parties.
