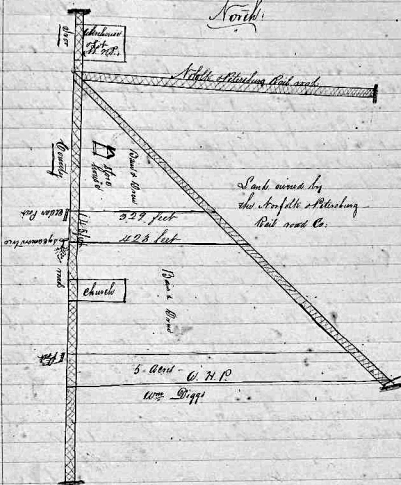

This deed made the 17th day of June in the year 1878 between Francis R. Rice of the first part and Charles A. Suter of the second part, witnesses that in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ten dollars, the said Francis R. Rice, with grant unto Charles A. Suter the following tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Staunton and State of Virginia containing thirty nine acres and adjoining the lands of William Drake, James Drake, Peter Drake and the said Francis R. Rice, and the said Francis R. Rice did warrant generally the land above conveyed. Witness the following signatures and seal.
