

This Deed made this 30th day of June in the year 1873, between John Williams and Mary C. his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and J. D. Parsons and G. T. Fairman of the County of Isle of Wight and State of Virginia of the second part, witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred dollars to them a bond paid before the sealing and delivery of this present, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said John Williams and Mary C. do make, publish and declare that the first part, being a grant, bargain, sale, exchange and convey, and by these presents have granted, sold and conveyed unto the said husband of the second part all their right, title and interest of and to a certain lot or piece of land, lying in the town of Franklin, County of Isle of Wight and bounded as follows, commencing at the North east corner of the P. R. R. Railroad track where the same runs past 1st Avenue, thence along 1st Avenue last South 224 feet to the head of the S. & P. Railroad track East along the head of said Railroad 177 feet to a stake, also thence the lot herein described and along 1st Avenue West 100 ft. to 6th Avenue last, thence along said street South 224 feet to 1st Avenue, thence along 1st Avenue West 177 feet to the point of beginning containing one acre and one tenth acre, together with all the improvements thereon and appurtenances belonging thereto, the above lot being the same described by deed of Survey and set by Robert W. Taylor, Clerk of the said County and to which reference is hereby made.
