Vaughan etc a before the sealing and delivery of these presents doth receipt whereof is fully acknowledged by the said Littleton A. Gray and Elizabeth Rose his wife of the County and State of Virginia of the one part and Civil L. Vaughan of the County and State of Virginia of the other part, all of them heretofore in a certain tract of land owned by William C. Gray deceased lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, which land and premises the said Littleton A. Gray and Elizabeth Rose his wife comes to the said Civil L.
