This Deed made the 1st day of October in the year 1873 between J. D. Butler, and Henry H. Lee wife of the first party, and Henry J. Webb of the second party, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Whereas, that in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred dollars, the said J. D. Butler and Henry H. Lee wife did grant and the said Henry Webb and certain heirs or personalty of land, situated to certain and hundred acres, more or less, being a part of the tract of land known as the Carr Edwards tract, and purchased by the said Richard Bennett & Henry Webb, his wife & Dorothy Bennett, and living on the N.W. side of the public road leading from Mrs. Henry Webb to Mrs. Judith Pitts, and being that part of which the dwelling house is situated and about one fourth of an acre more or less lying on the leeward, next to Mrs. Henry Webb and on the opposite side of land made and contained in the following boundaries beginning at the southw. corner of a certain Oak tree said Oak being on the line between the said J. D.
