Whereas, that whereas the said Robert Turner is indebted to Willis Broadshaw in the sum of One hundred twenty four dollars & 56 cts (1794.56) due by bond bearing date with these presents and payable on demand with interest thereon at the rate of per centum per annum, and whereas the said Robert Turner is willing and desirous to secure the payment of the said bond, Now this day further testified that the said Robert Turner in consideration, of the premises aforesaid, and of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Charles M. Jagers Trustee, doth grant with quittance accordingly unto the said Charles M. Jagers Trustee aforesaid the following property to wit, One parcel or tract or more and give thereof, and it is Covenanted between the parties that the said Charles M. Jagers Trustee, shall not be paym^t for any part of the property herein before mentioned, before the sale thereof and that when a sale shall take place, it shall be made according to law. This deed made this 25th day of September 1793 between Joseph H. Harris and Mary C. his wife of the County of Surry State of Virginia grantors of the first part and Henry T. Coll of the County of Southampton and same State grantees of the second part. Whereas that in consideration of the sum of ten hundred dollars paid by said H. T. Coll to them the said Joseph H. Harris & Mary C. his wife, they do grant unto him the said Coll the following real property to wit, their entire right, title and interest in a certain parcel or tract of land, being said Harris did survey and possessed lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton and situated as follows bounded on the South by the now known as the Third Creek, on the East and North by the land of William Jones on the West by the land of Thomas Applewhite, containing by estimation six hundred and fifty said interest being that they the said Joseph H. Harris & Mary C. his wife have in the above mentioned tract said tract having formerly belonged to Joel Harris. And the said Joseph H. and Mary C.
