This Bond made the 20th day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and
 seventy four between Amos S. Pope the Grantor of the said part and Franklin S. Pope Trustee
 of the other part all of Southampton County Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Amos S. Pope
 Grantor did grant unto the said Franklin S. Pope Trustee the following property to wit, all of the
 tract of land formerly owned by Jas. J. Parsons lying on the East side of the road leading
 from Cape Hope to Pamunkey except four acres sold to Cuth. A. Pope containing 140 acres
 more or less and bounded by the land of A. S. Pope, Jas. Pope, B. S. Knight others, also the tract
 of land on which R. S. Bryant now lives and containing 5 or 6 acres more or less and bounded by the
 lands of Jas. Wright Mrs. Arthur Whiting, R. S. Barnes others, and trust to secure a Bond to
 Henry Ferguson of and thousand Dollars bearing date the 17th day of January 1847. Should the
 said A. S. Pope fail to pay the said Bond the said Trustee shall sell at the request of the said
 Henry Ferguson all a enough of the above land to pay the said Bond and interest and costs
 and the balance here over to the said A. S. Pope. Witness the following seals and signatures this

This Bond made the 15th day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and
 seventy four between Mrs. S. Kindred (Grantor) of the first part and Richard S. Bryant of the
 other part, all of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Witnesseth as follows: That
 the said Richard S. Bryant by Bond of Bond executed to the said Kindred Trustee as above,
 (where) said Bond of Bond was admitted to record in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of
 Southampton County on the seventh day of March 1840. did among other things, grant and
 convey to the said Kindred Trustee "all of the interest of the said Bryant in the tract of land
 on which Mrs. Elizabeth Hill now resides and four or five acres" the whole tract supposed
 to contain four hundred acres more or less - it being all of the right title and interest
 which the said Richard S. Bryant may have by virtue of his marriage with his wife Mary S.
 Bryant (who was still a daughter of Mrs. Henry S. Hill deceased) - the interest of the said
 Richard S. Bryant being and partly of the whole of said tract of land - but the said
 Mary S. Bryant not having been a party to the said Bond of Bond her interest in said land
 was not granted, but only the interest of the said Richard S. Bryant was granted thereto.
 And whereas the said Kindred did as Trustee as above said all of the said Richard S.
 Bryant interest in the said land, at auction, on the 7th day of January A.D. 1842.
 having duly advertised the same, and the said R. S. Bryant purchased the purchase for the sum
 of fifty dollars and has fully paid the same, the receipt of which said sum is hereby
 acknowledged - Now the said Kindred doth certify that the said Mrs. S. Kindred Trustee as above,
 for and for consideration of the purchase doth hereby grant and convey to the said Richard S. Bryant
 with special warranty, all of the right title interest of every kind of which the said Richard S.
 Bryant was formerly seized and possessed in and to the said tract of land before described.
