Agreement made this 15th day of December 1843 between Wm. M. Bristol and John J. Kindred. The said Wm. M. Bristol has this day purchased at auction of Wm. M. Briggs Sheriff a certain parcel of land, the lands now situated in the County of Southampton, belonging to Dr. J. Kindred for the sum of one hundred and seventy five dollars. And the said Wm. M. Bristol covenants and agrees with the said John J. Kindred as follows: That is to say, That if the said John J. Kindred shall within one year from this day, pay to the said Bristol, his heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns, or shall, or shall cause to be paid, the sum of money agreed upon, with interest thereon and all expenses & costs which may have been incurred by said Bristol, his heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns, about said purchase, that then the said Bristol, his heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns will pay to the said Kindred or assigns or his may debt, agreed to for said land containing all the debt the said Bristol may have - and the said Kindred or his heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns will pay to the said Bristol, his heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns the said sum of money and all interest & costs and expenses as aforesaid, that then he will surrender the said premises to said Bristol, his heirs, or assigns without notice and without trouble or contention, and pay a ^{proportionable} sum for the use of the place.
