Whereas John J. Meyer and Josephine his wife and Co. to Ferguson, by their Deed of Sale dated the
15th day of March one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine, did, in order to secure Abram
Riddick, four thousand five hundred dollars with interest at three percent, money unto John R.
Kelly, the trustee named, thereon the following property, to wit, a tract of land in the County of
Loudoun, Virginia, containing twenty two hundred and sixty acres, by survey, mark or lot, and is part
of the farm known at the "Alton" residence farm, and at about John D. Jenkins recently deceased and
which was conveyed to said Meyer and Ferguson by Abram Riddick and wife by Deed dated the 15th day
of March 1869 - and whereas the said Meyer & Ferguson have paid off and discharged the said debt
and full payment thereon made the 25th day of January 1844, between the said John Kelly, trustee
of Ferguson, of the one part and the said Meyer and Ferguson of the other part, witnesseth That the
said John R. Kelly, as trustee of Ferguson, doth, in consideration of the premises and of one dollar, Receive
and Rebut, the said land and appurtenances, unto the said Meyer and Ferguson and to their heirs

Whereas at the 24th day of August 1841, Caswell C. Ferguson and John J. Meyer & Josephine
his wife by their Deed of bargain sold the 1st and County unto John R. Kelly, a tract of land in
Loudoun County, Virginia, known as "Alton's Quarter" and containing twenty two hundred and sixty
acres, lying at the right bank of the Potowmack River, and at Jessopsville, and which was recently
conveyed by John D. Jenkins, and which shall subject to him by Deed of Sale to send a debt to
Jas. M. Barkman and to Abram Riddick, also all the Corps of Stream, ground frost, corn, fowl, fletched,
and all other Corps that growing on said land and belonging to the said Ferguson & Meyer; and
whereas the objects which caused the execution of said deed sold, have ceased to exist, and the said
Caswell C. Ferguson & Meyer, had agreed to said Kelly all the Consideration annexed in the said Sale, and the
said Kelly being willing to will, all what thus concerns to him, took again to said Ferguson
& Meyer. Therefore the said deed made this 20th day of January 1844, between the said John R. Kelly
of the one part and the said Ferguson & Meyer of the other part, witnesseth That the said John
R. Kelly, in consideration of the premises and also the further sum of five dollars, doth grant with
special warranty, the said land and appurtenances, and the said personal property, unto the said
Ferguson & Meyer and to their heirs and assigns forever. Witness the following signature and seal.
