This Deed, made this 23rd day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty four between H. R. Beaton and H. R. Beaton his wife of the first part, and R. J. Knight of the second part. Whereas that in Consideration of the sum of four hundred and seventy five dollars, the said H. R. Beaton and A. M. Beaton his wife, do grant unto the said R. J. Knight with general warranty a certain lot, situate near Raykins Neck, on the East side of the road, leading from Raykins Neck to M. Conners, &c. the boundaries of the said lot being as follows, to wit: Commencing in public road, running East along line of fence and ditch of the lot, occupied by Mr. Woodhull, seventy yards to a strip, then North to state, thirty five yards then West from the state seventy yards to Road then South to beginning thirty four yards the said lot being situated directly opposite lot conveyed by deed of this date from the said first part to Alexander Knight. The said H. R. Beaton his husband and wife, covenants that he has the right to convey the said land to the grantee; that he has done so as to encumber the said land, that the grantee shall have quiet possession of the said land, free from all encumbrances and that he the said H.
