This First of trust made this 28th day of January 1872 between Henry Read and himself his wife of the first part, Jane A. Hamlin trustee of the second part, and H. H. Read of the third part Wethersfield, that in consideration of the hereinbefore mentioned sum or sums the said parties of the first part do grant and convey with general warranty to the said Jane A. Hamlin trustee as aforesaid, to hold and her heirs female, the following real estate to wit: a certain tract of land situated in Tolland County, Connecticut, U.S.A., viz the said land or lot, the same being part of the real estate formerly belonging to James Bryant and which was conveyed to said H.
