This Note of Trust made this 24<sup>th</sup> day of Aug. 1844, between James C. Vick, widow oficular  
Note due, J. D. Griffis, and Mary A. Griffis his wife, parties of the first part; Joseph A. Griffis trustee  
of the second party and J. D. Price of the third, party. Not in consideration of the hermaphro-  
tid name, the said parties of the first part do grant and convey with general warranty, to the said  
J. D. Price, Justice of the peace and his wife, the following real Estate, to wit, a certain tract of land  
situate in Southampton County, containing 170 1/4 acres. At the same house or lot, bounded by the lands  
of Jas. Ferguson, Leonard Sharp, Caleb Evans and others, the same being the tract of land of which  
Mother Vick's died since. In trust however to secure a debt due the said by J. D. Griffis  
and Mary A. Vick for five hundred dollars by bond of record made and executed and carrying  
interest at the rate of twelve per cent for annum. And it is agreed by the parties to this note,  
that no suit shall be taken by either herself or the parties of the first part from this date,  
provided that interest at the debt hereby secured is paid promptly at or before Jan'y 24<sup>th</sup> 1845; but  
unless judgment is at the discretion of the said Griffis. It is further agreed, that in case of sale  
of property, that it shall be upon strict notice from the said Griffis to the trustee, and after  
30 days notice of sale and place of sale and upon such terms as the said Griffis may prescribe, and  
in such event, the trustee shall be entitled to receive a compensation of five per cent of gross sales.
