This deed records the 21st day of January in the year A.D. 1859 between Alexander H. Bowley and Mary C. his wife, of the County of Lancaster and State of Virginia, of the first part, and Willis H. Lawrence of said County and State of the second part Testifying that for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars to them paid and received by the said Willis H. Lawrence the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge, they the said Alexander H. Bowley and Mary his wife do grant and convey unto the said Willis H. Lawrence all their right title and interest now or ever to that certain parcel of land lying in the town of Franklin, Lancaster County, and bounded as follows: Beginning at a point on the West side of Main street fifty feet and one half feet northerly from the front thereof in a westerly direction thirty and four feet Accross thence northerly along said street until it comes to Church Street thence westerly along said street about one hundred and fifteen feet to Carter Esau and that church darüber to a point midway between friends and back corner to the same westerly in a straight line to the South west corner of a lot of land conveyed by said Willis H. Lawrence to W. Bowley and Mary his wife to Mr. and M. Lawrence, thence northerly along the line of Willis H. Lawrence and W. Lawrence fifty feet and one half feet thence Eastward about one hundred and ten feet to the point of beginning Containing about one half acre and one half acre of land and that it is free from all encumbrance.
