This indenture made and entered into on the 20th day of January in the year of our Lord 1714, between Stephen Deane and Henry de Arden, of the County of Suffolk in the State of Virginia of the first part, and Francis Mc Holland of the County of Somersetshire State of England of the second part, Witnesseth That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Pounds dollars to us in hand paid by the said Francis Mc Holland the receipt of which we do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth bargain sell and convey unto the said Francis Mc Holland his heirs and assigns a lot of land in the village of Brookfield containing not quite an acre and a half, fronting on the West end of the third fifty eighth, third section and running back to the adjoining lot it is to be made the East and rather narrower than the West end, which lot adjoins the lot of J. Mc Chasins on the South, and the West on the West and North. The lot is sold and purchased by and from B. Fisher and Brother son John de Killy a Commission which said negroes is not made for further particulars together with all the privileges and advantages and covenants belonging or to come unto the said land, which the said Francis Mc Holland has and assigns James McGowan of the said party of the first part doth accept and agree to, and unto the said party of the second part after the signing of these presents to accept and receive the right and title of the adjoining lot of land with several covenants unto the said Francis Mc Holland and to his heirs and assigns forever.
