part and N. R. Griffin trustee of Southampton County and State of the second part. Notwithstanding the
said G. A. Davis and Henry F. his wife, doth acknowledge and declare that he is hereby
acknowledged by the said G. A. Johnson and Henry F. his wife, as great damage both unto
Henry F. his wife by their present have sustained, sold unto George F. his wife, the said N. R. Griffin, each
quarter yearly, all that certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and
State of Virginia containing one hundred and sixty acres, and bounded on the north by
the lands of John Miller Jr. on the south by the lands of R. H. Shaw and on the east
and west by the lands of George Gardner, together with all improvements thereon and appurtenances
belonging thereto, to have and to hold the said tract of land to him the said N. R. Griffin
as his and his wife's forever. In Trust to bear the payment of a debt executed by the said
G. A. Davis on the 24th day of February 1870 for the sum of two hundred and forty nine
dollars and twenty five cents with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum
