Johnson* the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said *Alexander Gordon* that great bargain well and lawfully and by these presents lawfully granted bargain sold and conveyed unto the said *W. A. Johnson* all his right title and interest in and to that certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing by situation twenty and four acres and bounded on the north by the Lands of *John P. Johnson* on the south by the Lands of *Matthew R. Johnson* and on the East and West by the Lands of *Samuel Gordon* it being the said tract of land which the said *W. A.
