This Act of Release made this second day of March in the year one thousand
 and eight hundred and seventy four between Rufus C. Norwood, David C. Pope and James R.
 Ferguson of the first part, and Debat H. H. Rely (Child), of the second part (Child of the
 County of Southampton, State of Virginia) Witnessed as follows: Whereas the said H. H. Rely died
 by Will of Trust duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of said County, on the 10th
 day of March A. D. 1873, grant and convey to the said Norwood, Trustee, a certain tract of
 land lying in said County, and in the said Act of Trust deposited to wit: a tract of land lying
 and situated near James's River in said County, containing sixty four acres more or less and
 bounded on the North by the land of David D. Norwood, on the East by the Sea Beach
 Norwood's Rock Road and the lands of the said David Norwood, on the South by the said
 Rock Road and the lands of John Norwood and Emma Norwood, and on the West by the lands of
 the said David Norwood and Emma Norwood. And said tract of land was granted to the said Trustee
 in trust to secure the payment of a certain bond or note due to the said Ferguson for the sum of
 three hundred and seventeen dollars, dated July 2nd 1873 and due eight months after
 date and to secure the payment of a certain other bond or note for the sum of one hundred and
 eighty five dollars due to Benjamin C. Pope, dated the 1st day of March 1873. And
 whereas the said Debat H. Rely has fully paid and satisfied the said two bonds (promissories) and intends
 to the said B. C. Pope and J. R. Ferguson. Now this Act witnesses that the said Rufus
 C. Norwood, (Trustee) and the said James R. Ferguson and David C. Pope, parties of the first part
 do hereby release and forever acquit all right title interest or claim of every kind whatsoever
 in and to the said note above, to the said Debat H. H. Rely, just the same as if the said
