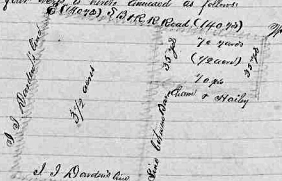

The Bond made the second day of November and the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy four between David R. Bailey and Virginia his wife of the first part & David S. Norwood of the other part, witnesses that the said Bailey wife, for good and lawful value of the sum of Ten hundred dollars paid to him by the said Norwood the receipt of which said sum is hereby acknowledged, do grant and convey to the said Norwood four acres of the said Norwood's Shop in Southampton County, it being a part of a tract of land lying in the said quantity the whole of which said tract is supposed to contain sixty four acres more or less - the said four acres hereby intended to be granted is cut off and bounded as follows that is to say the line to Commence at the point where the said tract of land was the line of David S. Norwood's and a corner in the Sea Beach and thence said said line runs towards the City of Portsmouth to and thence West (or towards Holden) immediately upon entering the said said line for the distance of two acres, to and thence North and forty paces to the said said line and up the same, and at the upper or Western end of the said first (or at the point where the said said line and the said said line and forty paces) a half, it is to be cut off, which said half acre is to pass on the said said line and (70) paces and to run back North the distance of thirty (35) feet paces, and the remaining land and a half acre is to be made by continuing the Eastern end of the said half acre back to the Western division to David S. Norwood's line and thence continuing said said Norwood's line East and thence as to complete the four acres aforesaid.

A plot of the said four acres is hereby annexed as follows



And the said parties of the first part do grant and convey the said parcel or lot of land to the said Norwood's line and thence as to complete the four acres aforesaid.
