

Mess'd by a deput'y of the Circuit Court of Lancaster County, return'd at the 5th Inst 1874,
at the Chancery suit of Lewis C. Harris ag'nt against Lewis C. Harris, it was among other things entered, that C. H.
Harris, never had the block of the said Lancaster Court a suit against Lewis C. Harris, filed in said

whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said C. H. Harris Commissioner doth grant and
convey with special warranty to the said Lewis C. Harris, the tract of lands, whereof Lewis Harris
did pay, situated in Lancaster County, containing 4.65 acres, to the said number, bounded
by the lands of Lewis C. L. Linnard, John S. Appelwhite, and Peter H. Appelwhite, same being tract
