Trustee with general warranty, the following property, to wit, One black land one acre  
bare, and white ground and her factors measure, twenty-eight head of hogs and three flocks  
several, house hogs and kitchen furniture, consisting of face bread and other necessary articles;  
and Coch and barrels, forming a compleat of every kind. It trust to remain the following etc  
that Mr. E. Myrick get land for thirty seven dollars dated and due August 24<sup>th</sup> 1874, also  
land for thirty five dollars dated and due September 22<sup>nd</sup> 1874, Another land for six dollars  
during his life dated and due December 8<sup>th</sup> 1874. And another land for six hundred and three  
dollars and 87/100. — It is hereby covenanted and agreed between the parties to live the  
that no sale shall take place under the said without the consent of the said Edwin Rader  
prior to the 26<sup>th</sup> of May 1874 and that when a sale does take place, shall not be more  
any it shall be for cash, after giving twenty days notice of the time and place of sale,  
the proceeds after paying the cost and expenses of the sale shall be applied to the paying  
of the aforesaid lands due the said Mr. E. Myrick, the balance of any sum over \$100
