she may be entitled out of his testate, and Ward Penny, and male & female slave, stock of
cattle and hogs, 5 Mts and Bedchairs, 1 piano, 1 Rockaway, 2 carts and wheels, and all of her
other household and kitchen furniture, and all of the Crops of every kind, which may be raised
by her this year. & trust to receive the sum of Eleven hundred and Eighty one dollars
a dozen and five Cents created by the said Sarah E. Briggs and Thos A. Hobbs to H. McCall
as a compensation of Plaintiff S. Briggs dec'd, dated the 17th day of March 1879, and payable six months
after date being interest from the date of the said bond witness the following signatures

in 1574 by kind and half of a bushel of Oatlin he may have & trust to receive the payment of one
Examined & Ackd. In Fifty five dollars dated the 12th day of February 1871 and paid 1st for 1574 to
be paid to Hobbs at New York but if it should be necessary to sell the said property for the payment of said

County and then sell said property ex except of it to satisfy said note for cash for the
