Saylor's side one cow and four pigs and interest, 1 for Cows wheels and by Cows' side, 1 wheel, 1 frame, 1 bedstead and trussing and covering to same, 3 or 4 weed bars and 1 Quail bed 11th of Chans 2 or 3 plus bars Cows gear and plus gear 2 cows and two Crops of all kinds to be made in 1872 by him and half of a bale of Cotton he now has. He trust to secure the payment of one dollar and fifty cents for the said property or enough of it to satisfy said note for each year the said note and each and shall pay the balance due to said note.
