Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars and five cents paid by James A. Blanton unto the said Haddad Peirce he the said Haddad Peirce doth grant unto the said James A. Blanton all of his entire interest or right in any way whatever he now has or may hereafter have in and to the piece of land now lying and being in Old No. Peirce land containing thirty acres more or less and bounded by the lands of P. E. Ferguson and J. R. Barnden and lands in possession of Jas. A.
