Shands, of the County of York, State of Virginia, of the second part, that the said Dyer wife do hereby grant and convey to the said George A. Shands, following property, to wit: all of that tract or parcels of land in which the said Dyer wife was sole owner, lying in said County, and is supposed to contain twenty six acres and or less, the boundaries of which was granted to the said Dyer by Anthony Harris, in the year 1852, and is bounded on the north by the lands lately belonging to Anthony Harris, on the east by the lands of Augustus Smith, on the south by the lands lately belonging to James R. and Wm. A. Joyce (Commonly called the White Plains tract), and on the west by the lands lately owned by James Dyer (Commonly called the White Plains tract), and all the said parcels do further grant unto the said George A.
