First Deed made this 2d day of March 1874 between William A. Day and Elizabeth R. his
wife of the County of Southampton State of Virginia grantors of the first part, and David L. Bayard
of the same County and State, Plaintiff at law of the second part, Plaintiff, that the said William A. Day
and Elizabeth R. his wife grantee, doth grant unto defendant, his judgment amounting unto the sum of \$1,000.
to Plaintiff, paid him the following notwithstanding to wit: a certain parcel or tract of land in the
opposite County of Desharnais and situated as follows bounded North by the lands of Elihu
Foy and A. R. Cluff, East by the land of Parker J. Scudder, South by the land of W.L.
Hawkins, and west by the Jonathan road, it being the land known as the Cherry tract, and
containing 100 acres and hundred and five (105) acres more or less said land being the same in
suit to S.R. Edwards who said W.A. Day grants, in trust to secure the following debt and rate of one hundred
fifty and six dollars (\$145.60) dollars dated March 2nd 1874, and due November 2nd 1874.
said note being in favor of S.H. Neffet, S.R. Edwards and A.C. Scott under the firm name of
A.H. Neffet & Co. And the said W.A. Day and Elizabeth R. his wife do jointly and right
make the title herein conveyed to their land and promises to make any further assurance necessary
to giving a perfect and undivided title to the same for the payment herein before mentioned in
