This Deed made the first day of January in the year 1874, between John Pritchard and Eva B. his wife
John Coll and Martha his wife, and Henry V. Clegg of the County of Bucks and State of Virginia, of the first
part and Thomas Johnson of said County and State of the second part, witnesseth, that for and consideration of
the sum of One hundred and twenty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Johnson, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, they the said John Pritchard and Eva B. his wife, John Coll and Martha his wife
and Henry V. Clegg do grant, transfer and convey and by that presents have granted, transferred and conveyed
unto the said Thomas Johnson all their right title and interest in and to that certain lot or parcels of land lying
in the town of Southampton County, and at the High side of Standard Street between Second and Third
Street beginning at the intersection of Standard Street and Second Avenue, running generally along Third Street to a point one
said Avenue about One hundred and four feet from its intersection with Standard Street, thence Southward
along a straight line about ten hundred and two feet to a point of second Avenue about One hundred
and five feet from its intersection with Standard Street Eastward along second Street about One
hundred and four feet to Standard Street, the point of beginning, containing six lots and a
part half acre of land, according to the Map of Southampton he had sent to him, with general accuracy. To

to the said party of the second part to interfere with or restrain the full use and sale and use it shall be allowed in case
