

The Deed of Trust made the 10th day of April 1874 between Joseph H. Clark
and Emma A. Clark his wife of the first part, Joseph H. Prince, Trustee of second part,
and Old Edwards of third part, Whitefield, that being consideration of the heretofore done
presents the said parties of the first part do grant and convey with general warranty, to the
said trustee the following real estate to wit a tract of land situated in Southampton County,
Carolina, for ever to the said man or his heirs some being tract of land on which said Old Edwards
lives, bounded by lands of J. C. Clark, Wm. S. Jones, James Pittsford, others and a tract
of land situated in said County, containing 1000 acres to the said man or his heirs, same being tract
of land known as "The Hill Place" and bounded by the lands of Joe H. Edwards, Sam. Parker,
Walt Darrow, the Estate of Sam. Darrow, others. In trust to secure the payment of a sum
of one hundred and eighty seven & 75/100 dollar, due E. S. Pritchard to J. C. Clark, on
or about the 1st day of January 1875. And it is agreed by the parties to this deed that no part of the
sum shall be paid before January 1st 1875, but it is further agreed that in event of a sale, the trust
shall be entitled to five per cent Commission. Witness the following signature and seals.

part, John Cott of the second part, and Michael Parker of the third part, Whitefield, where by
Certain deed bearing date the 15th of December 1871 made between Nathan Edwards, son of the
first part and said Nathan R. Edwards, trustee of the second part, the following and premises
was conveyed to the said Nathan R. Edwards trustee, Whitefield, to wit a certain tract of land
containing in the County of Southampton State of Virginia and bounded as follows at the west
by the following signs and ditch by the lands of Edward Rogers and Samuel Darrow, being
on the east by the lands of Charles Bradwell and on the north by the lands of Jacob Park-
er and about forty rods long and half acre more or less, being the tract of land owned by him and his
wife and their children, and the said land containing by estimated about twenty-five acres
by said deed was conveyed unto the said Nathan Edwards, trustee, by the said Parker, the said
deed, specifically to wit, ten acres, one half acre, cattle, household and kitchen furniture, tools
implements and & tools, all going, kept, carts and wagons and all else belonging to him and his
wife, to secure the following debt, or rate of six hundred dollars due by each
