This Deed made the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April 1874, between Gordon Parker, grantor of the first party, and  
John Colle, Lester R. Edwards, claimant to bound land of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the  
in same, Rockingham tract, Wellerfield, that the said Gordon Parker doth grant the said Lester R. Edwards tract  
described, with generally accuracy, as follows and property to wit, A certain tract of land  
lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton, situated as follows, bounded at the west by William  
Hill by the lands of Mr. Otto and Henry Colle and James Langham East by  
the lands of George Daniel and Narcissa Daugherty and South by the lands of Alberto  
and others. Title said land being the tract at which said Gordon Parker resided at least to serve the  
to Lester R. Edwards, following debt to wit, and for his unpaid labor bearing date April 1st 1874, and note  
Edwards, amounting about \$100.00, Gordon Parker to Samuel R. Hill and due 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1875.
