

Notarized Now before me Richard Poynter the witness of John Poynter Esq: deceased of Southampton County Virginia was powerfuled to have hundred and eighty seven acres of land a life in said County where he held at Davis in the hands of his said widow and wife of his death passed to the children and heirs of said John Poynter the late Richard S. Poynter, Thomas P. wife of John Le Griffon and Mary E. wife of John Le Griffon
 Hampshire all of whom are now twenty one year of age and whereas the said John Le Griffon has purchased of said Richard S. Poynter his share (one third) and has his in the sum of Fourteen hundred dollars and has also purchased the share (one third) of the said of Charles hundred and fifty dollars. Now therefore the aforesaid made this 2nd day of March One thousand eight hundred and forty four before the said Richard S. Poynter and Thomas his wife and Edmund H. Vaughan and Mary E. his wife of the said part and the said John Le Griffon of the other part. Witness the parties of the first part in consideration of the said sum of money respectively paid to them by the said John Le Griffon at a present to him and his wife Mary E. said John Le Griffon paid to the said Edmund H. Vaughan which adjoined the lands of said H. H. Vaughan and wife John Poynter Esq: together with all his singulars the aforesaid belonging to the said - and the parties of the first part consented to convey the title to the land hereby sold to said John Le Griffon and to his wife and his wife forever.
