Wherein that the said Isaac Glover and Margaret his wife and Elijah Glover do grant with covenanted warranty only the said Benjamin J. Bryant as grantee, a Certain tract or parcel of land in the County of DuSable State of Virginia, containing Sec (21st) Township and out and a half acre more or less and is bounded by the lands of George C. Whitfield, Abner Henry Whitfield, St. Mary Rungles and others together with all and singular the appurtenances belonging to the same. And that to secure the payment of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to be paid to the said B. J. Bryant and to his several assigns heirs or assigns, with interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum from the 1st Jan. 1874 till paid, and where said sum is secured by four Bonds signed by the said Isaac Glover and Elijah Glover dated 1st Jan. 1874, and payable as follows: First Bond dated January 1st 1874; payable January 1st 1875; second Bond dated January 1st 1874; payable January 1st 1876; third Bond dated January 1st 1874; payable January 1st 1877; fourth Bond dated January 1st 1874; payable January 1st 1878. And the said Isaac Glover and Elijah Glover covenants that they have the right to sell and convey the said Bond that they have done so but to remember the same, that the grantor shall have quiet possession and also the purchaser from said Estate should a sale be made and that all further expenses of said property shall be made that may be necessary.
