Read thence N 45° E. 7 ch to a tree thence N 17 1/2 E 50 ch to a tree then N 42 1/2 E 2 ch to Franklin Road N 45 1/2 E 3 57 ch to Maple thence N 41 1/2 E 2 25 ch to Maple thence S 57 1/2 E 5 1/2 ch to Maple after for J. Dillard (his tract) J. Daughtry, J. Edwards and Brothers thence N 53 1/2 E 10 1/2 ch to a tree thence S 47 1/2 E 4 ch to R. Read thence a line of timbered land at each side of a ditch to Franklin Road thence along said road S 50 1/2 W 24 50 ch to R. Read thence S 57 1/2 E 10 1/2 ch to point at beginning. Containing south of R. Read 163 1/2 acres and North of R. Read 5 1/2 acres.
