Examination 9 This Deed made this 16th day of November in the year 1872 between Priscilla Chamberlain the first part, and Alfred McNeil of the second part, Wintonshire, that for and in consideration of the sum of forty dollars to me just now paid by said Alfred McNeil of the second part, I have given, granted, bargained sold and conveanted to Alfred McNeil of the second part my interest (which is my life interest) in a certain tract or parcel of land known as part of No. 100 in this tract, lying and being in the County of Southampton, Virginia, consisting of twenty acres more or less and bounded as follows: that is to say, beginning at a holly tree near County road and land bordering to Mr. Henry A. White, on line of H. A. McNeils land and running thence west west directed by a large white oak in field side, and in same direction to street and through west back door, and thence in same direction to center backland swamp, to low of land where said backland meets the land the south east boundary and bounded south west by the land of H. A. McNeils and north west by the land of state. Exhibited Smith for a more particular description of which reference is hereby made to the Commissioners' report, bearing date Nov 14th 1872, altered and agreeing to me the said tract of land, having no natural life, I warrant and defend the premises hereby conveyed against the claims or demands of any and all persons whatever.

This Deed made this 16th day of November 1872, between Britton A. Bryant the grantor of the first part of the County of Southampton State of Virginia, and Wm. H. Gratiot (the tanner) of the second part of the same County and State aforesaid. Whereas that in and in consideration of one dollar in hand paid to the party of the first part by W. H. Gratiot (the tanner) the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Britton A. Bryant doth grant and by these presents do grant and convey unto Wm. H. Gratiot (the tanner) following heretofore to wit: one black mule and saddle and four sheets and my entire crop of cotton fields & that I may produce this present year 1874, and the farm where I now reside my trust to secure the following debt, and note due Mr. A. McNeil by and Britton A. Bryant of one hundred and ten dollars and eighty six cents dated 1st January 1872, and in demand with interest the rate of eight per cent per annum and an open account due Mr. A. McNeil and Peter A. McNeil under the form and style of W. H. Gratiot the sum of sixty five dollars and said account to be paid under my hand and seal this day and date as first above written.
