Hester, of the County and State aforesaid, of the second part. Whereas, that the said party of the first part, doth own to the party of the second part, land enough sufficient for a cow lease, of the first part, by said parties, for the year 1874, said land to be cultivated in corn and cotton, as appears by the said parties, in consideration for which, the said party, of the second part, is to pay to the said party of the first part, out of the crops raised on the said tract of land, and also agree to deliver to the said party, that the party of the second part, binds his part of the crops, that is to say, to the said party of the first part, a enough thereof, to pay said party of the first part, the amount of two hundred dollars, which amount said party of the first part, agrees to pay during the year to said party of second part, in portions, to wit, money and other articles, of the party of the second part, to satisfy him for amount advanced, he is authorized to do so at full rate, giving two days notice, and still for cash, until enough is received to satisfy the claim of the party of the first part.
