W. & O. R. P. on the East by lands of said Richard S. Boylston, on the south by lands of M^{rs} M. A. Newbery and on the east by what is termed as Waterworks Road: to have and to hold forever.

Examined This Deed made and entered into the 25th day of May in the year of our Lord and of the said State of Virginia the eighth hundred and seventy four between R. S. Boylston and Anne his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and R. S. Boylston of the same County and District of the other part. Witnesseth that the said R. S. Boylston and Anne his wife for and in consideration of the natural love and affection they bear to the said R. S. Boylston have granted and conveyed unto and to the said R. S. Boylston his heirs and assigns forever, and certain lots of land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County and State respectively in front of R. S. Boylston's residence containing about two acres more or less commencing at a cedar post in Charles River street seventy yards east of R. S. Boylston's front gate thence a straight line south to a cedar post at the said R. S. Boylston's back fence and thence the said street and being forty yards to a cedar post thence north or straight line to a cedar post in the well road thence up the well road west to the beginning and bounded North by the land of Sir J. Abbot and all other points by R. S. Boylston's land to have and to hold the above described land tract a lot of land unto him the said R. S. Boylston his heirs and assigns forever, and the said R. S. Boylston and Anne his wife for the purpose of giving a third part of said half acre the said half acre to be situated at any point in the line aforesaid between the said R. S. Boylston and R. S.
