

This Deed made this 12<sup>th</sup> day of June 1874 between William H. Smith  
of the first part (Grantor) and David M. Curtis (Donee), of the second part, Newbern; that  
the said Smith doth hereby grant and convey to the said Curtis the following property to wit; and  
whereas, our said real estate, and growing (crop), about twenty logs, including fence and other personal  
belongings, horses, carts, goods, live stock, hens, and all other growing implements of every  
kind, all the house helds and kitchen utensils, of every kind, and all personalty of the said estate,  
including beds, mattocks, bed-chests, bedsteads, and growing land and appurtenances, Cows, Cattle,  
and other wares - the Grantor's household tools - by right of all kinds, Cows, horses, flocks, Cattle,  
porkers, &c. In default to receive the payment of the following debts, to wit, one from account  
for about \$120. dollars due to Daniel Ely Jr., and account for about \$150. dollars due to  
W. H. Smith, and account for about \$25. dollars due to Alexander Wright, and account for  
about \$15. dollars due to John C. Sykes, and balance due to Francis J. Broome of Gloucester City  
an account about of 15. dollars. The said Charles also grants and conveys to the said Curtis  
(Donee) a general judgment obtained by him in the Circuit Court of Southampton County, at the  
Court, held on the 9<sup>th</sup> of May, 1874, for the sum of \$13. worth against Charles Smith, to be offset to the  
satisfaction of the above named debts. Kindly the following signature and seal:

County of Southampton, State of Virginia. That the said William Peterson doth grant unto the  
said W. G. Griffis his entire interest in his Crop of Cotton and peanut Cultivation at Banks Landing  
in the aforesaid County of Southampton. Said Crop of Cotton Consists in land in the amount of  
following debt to wit, and worth of sixty dollars doth paid the 19<sup>th</sup> of 1874, and due A. T.  
Holland, Mrs. and the said William Peterson hereby declares his right to carry the aforesaid  
Crop of Cotton and pledge himself to make any furtherances which may be necessary to carry
