This Deed made the 21st day of May 1874 between David Sumner grantor of the first part and the R. Kliffel Church as trustee party of the second part. Whereas, by the County of Southampton State of Virginia, that the said David Sumner doth grant unto the grantee of and lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton, and boundary running as follows: Commencing at a Cypress at the intersection of the Cedar Swamp Canal and James River about 1/2 mile above said Cypress being corner between said Sumner and C. R. Williams thence from said Cypress up said canal to the Richmond Rail Road thence down said canal Rail Road to center of Cedar Swamp thence down said swamp to point of beginning containing by estimation eighty acres more or less, it being the land sold by said David Sumner to Joseph Sumner of Tennessee and sold off of said County of Southampton said Joseph Sumner is bound to secure the following debt to wit: one hundred and fifty dollars dated May 31st 1874, said debt is due at land, as pledges himself to make any faithful appearance which may be necessary to carry out undisputed and perfect title.
