

Wm. H. Sherrill & Directors of Portsmouth Dr. and Dr. C. Sherrill of Southampton County, Va. have this day consulted and agreed to furnish the said Wm. H. Saunders with such supplies or advances as money, as he may need, not in excess of Two Hundred and fifty dollars \$250⁰⁰ for the purpose aforesaid, the said Wm. H. Saunders doth the 15th day of June A.D. 1873, give unto the said Elizur E. Sherrill & Directors of Dr. C. Sherrill a bill on his growing Corp of Corp, federal Cotton Penance to record the said advances and supplies to be furnished furnished before the date of the agreement and the 1st day of January A.D. 1875, by the said Elizur E. Sherrill & Dr. C. Sherrill & Dr. C. Sherrill will make payment to the said Wm. H. Saunders may defer payment as aforesaid that in the aggregate they do not exceed Two Hundred and fifty dollars. And it is further agreed that said amount to be furnished by the said Dr. C. Sherrill shall not exceed fifty dollars. Mrs. Elizur E. Sherrill & Directors agreeing to furnish the balance, that is to say (\$125⁰⁰) One hundred and twenty dollars.

This deed made the 17th day of December in the year 1873, between George H. Holland and Mary his wife of the first part and Samuel B. Poston and Mary his wife of the second part all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia. Whereas it is in consideration of twenty two acres of land more or less, the said George H. Holland, and grant unto the said S. B. Poston, a piece of land containing twelve acres bounded on the north by the road of S. B. Poston and the east by the land of George H. Holland and the south by land the title of which is disputed by said G. H. Holland & John C. Collier, and on the west by a long ditch running from S. B. Poston's land to the Creek adjoining John C. Collier's land. Notwith standing the said party of the first part debt comitant and above to and with the said party of the second part claim after the delivery of these presents to warrant generally the right and title of the aforesaid land to him the said S. B. Poston his heirs and assigns forever in which wherein we the said party of the first part hold currently at our hands a seal.
