Weston, P. J. Helms, W. H. Verghast and S. H. Marshall trustees for the Congregation of the Church of our Sister in Southwicks United States in the Diocese of Torquay of the second part. Whereas that the said Samuel J. Bain and Sarah his wife, in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars, or as aforesaid, S. D. Wells, R. U. Bangs, S. C. Dick, P. S. Weston, P. J. Helms, W. H. Verghast and S. H. Marshall trustees, aforesaid, a certain lot or parcel of land, at Dover in the County of Southwicks, containing at a large Experiment farm, the corner of W. St. Pasture, lot boundary exactly set in the Davidson and Fox Road running east to the line of the Atlantic Telegraph and other Rail Road Company and adjoining the lands of W. St. Pasture on the north east and lands of S. F. Bain at the south east. To have and to hold the said lot of land unto the said S. D. Wells, R. U. Bangs, S. C. H. Verghast, S. C. Dick, P. S. Weston, P. J. Helms, W. H. Verghast and S. H. Marshall trustees as aforesaid, and their successors, for trial for the quiet enjoyment of the said Congregation as a place for public worship and in conformity with and subject to the laws of the state of Torquay, in such case made and provided.
