first part, and William Dearborn of the other part, do said Darius of the County of Southampton and State
of Virginia and the said Josephine of the City of Norfolk in said State, Whereas, that the
said party of the first part, for and unto the consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars, by
the said Dearborn to the said Darius this day made, the receipt of which said sum is hereby acknow-
ledged, full payment and convey to the said Dearborn the following property, real and personal, to wit:
all of that tract of land on which the said Darius now resides, to wit: being the same which was
deeded to Dearborn and conveyed to her by Alfred, bearing date June 15th A.D. 1866, from John Allen, Clerk,
and which has long since been admitted to record, which said tract of land is supposed to contain eight
acres more or less, and is bounded by the lands formerly owned by Dr. Ellis (now owned by Henry
Wilkins) James Russell and others, to wit: being the same tract which was formerly owned by James
Wilkins and Henry (or now owned by Sally) four loads of cattle, viz: one cow and calf and
three yearlings and one and six shorthorns (all other large) two cows and three pairs of geese
