Whitcomb of the City of Norfolk and State of Virginia of the second part, Witnesseth that the said Charles Davis of the first part, in consideration of the premises and in full consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars in hand paid to the said Charles Davis by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have given, granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell with general warranty unto the said E. C. Whitcomb, part of of Southampton in the State of Virginia, known as the Williams tract, and bounded on the North by the lands belonging to the estate of the late James B. Whitcomb and on the East by the lands of Nathaniel Davis and on the West by the lands of Williams Shields, and containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less, it being the same tract of land which was conveyed to the said Charles Davis by Nathaniel Pillsbury dated the 26th day of March A. D. 1863 and of record in the office of the County Court of Southampton County, through the following signatures and seal.

Bayant, of the same place above named for the purchase price of two hundred dollars, of the other part, Witnesseth that the parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of five dollars, do grant, with general warranty unto the parties of the second part, situated as herein after named, and to their heirs and assigns, for the use of the members of the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, to erect a church and parsonage, or other church, the following and to wit: a lot or parcel of land in the County of Southampton County of the State of Virginia, situated on the North East corner formed by the junction of South Avenue and High Street, and running Northerly, along said South Avenue one hundred and thirty feet from Southampton at parallel to High Street, Eighteen feet more or less, to the City of Fairfax.
